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Information - Reinstatement after Suspension/Struck (Rules 151.1(1) and 87(1))

Following are the reinstatement requirements prescribed by the Rules of the Law Society of Yukon. Please note that the forms are available on our website.

All materials must be completed and returned to this office well in advance of the date that you wish to recommence practice in Yukon. Completed applications are considered by the Executive twice a month. Given the frequency of our meetings we do not anticipate any delays in considering your application. However, it is important to ensure you leave sufficient time between the date you submit your application and your proposed call date, to allow the Executive time to consider your application.

You are required to provide this office with the following:

1. A written application for reinstatement in Form 27.
2. Certificates of Standing from each Law Society of which you are presently a member or have ever been a member, dated not earlier than 60 days prior to the proposed date of reinstatement. Please ensure that you sign the Assurance and Authorization – Release of Information attached to the Certificate of Standing.
3. Form 13 - Annual Practice and Professional Liability Insurance Declaration.
4. Payment of all applicable fees (See Rules 87(1)(g) and 87(1)(h)).

Pursuant to Rule 151.1(2), the Executive **may** waive the requirements set out in Rule 151.1(1) upon the written request of the applicant. If you wish to submit a written request, you should indicate the specific exemptions you request and the reasons why you are of the view that an exemption should be granted.
