 - c) keep in strict confidence the affairs of the office of the Principal and his or her clients;

 - d) take proper care of and account for all property of the Principal, the Principal's office and any of his or her clients which may be entrusted to the Student-at-Law;

 - e) indemnify the Principal for any damage, injury, or loss that the Principal may suffer through a breach by the Student-at-Law of this agreement.

3. The Principal will, for the said term:
 - a) accept the Student-at-Law as the Principal's Student-at-Law;

 - b) use all reasonable means to advise and instruct the Student-at-Law in the profession of a barrister and solicitor;

 - c) at the expiration of the term assist the Student-at-Law at the request and expense of the Student-at-Law to be admitted as a barrister and solicitor in the Yukon Territory provided that the Student-at-Law has faithfully and diligently served the articles of Clerkship and has passed any examinations required of the Student-at-Law and properly qualified the Student-at-Law to be admitted to practice.

4. The Student-at-Law, shall as part of the student's service under articles:
- a) attend the bar admission course prescribed by the Law Society of Yukon;
 - b) successfully complete the bar admission course and examinations prescribed by the Law Society of Yukon;
 - c) successfully complete such other requirements as prescribed from time to time by the Law Society of Yukon.
